

Information about grade conversion

The grade point requirement for our Master's programmes differs for each course, but is generally a minimum of 2,0-2,5 (German grading system). It is calculated from all semesters of your Bachelor's studies (cumGPA) and converted as specified below.

Please note that the German grading system is based on a 1 to 4 scale, with 1 being the maximum grade.

Your grade will be converted according to the set guidelines of the Central Office of International Education using the so-called Modifizierte Bayerische Formel:

$N_{\max} - N_d$

----- * 3 + 1

$N_{\max} - N_{\min}$

The conversion will be carried out using the standard maximum mark (N_{\max}) and the lowest pass mark (N_{\min}) applicable in the country you obtained your certificates, as well as your grade point average as shown on your transcript (N_d).
