## FORMAL REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ The medical attestation in either German or English language has to be dated, signed and stamped by the practising doctor
- ✓ It should not be older than 1 year. Depending on the symptoms, you may have to present an even more recent attestation confirming your acute impairment
- ✓ The text should be understandable to those without a medical education



#### CONTENT

- Please provide a detailed description of the symptoms which are affecting you in the exam situation
- Actual diagnoses are not required but may be added. But the focus needs to be on the symptoms, since the examination board must consider each case individually. A diagnosis alone may lead to misconsumptions.
- ➤ A few sentences are sufficient as long as they state how the symptoms disturb the existing capacity to perform in a particular exam scenario (e.g. written or oral testing, presentation, group or home tasks)
- Recommendations of special exam arrangements which may help the patient can be stated (e.g. extra time, separate room, breaks or aids)
