- Represent the field of Digital Media Design in teaching and research in the bachelor degree programme "Information and Communication Design" as well as in the master degree programme "Digital Media".
- The teaching of design-relevant technologies, processes and methods in the development of interface concepts and modes of interaction: from conception, through prototyping to realisation.
- The introduction of design students to digital media design themes and fields of expertise: from generative design to media spaces and intermediality.
- Supporting students in the exploration and understanding of design perspectives, as
 well as playing with and speculating about them when integrating digitality in future
 products, systems and services in the midst of an increasingly fragmented and hybrid
 world.
- Actively collaborate with the private sector in applied research efforts, contribute to the further development of the university and research institutes, promote technology transfer between research and practice
- Impart course-related knowledge and expertise in bachelor's and master's degree programmes
- Participate in interdisciplinary collaboration with other degree programmes at Rhine-Waal University.

By German law, candidates must fulfil the **general statutory employment prerequisites** as stipulated by Section 36 of the Act Governing the Universities of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia (Hochschulgesetz – HG). These include in particular:

- A completed degree in a related subject from an accredited university
- Special aptitude for scientific work, usually demonstrated by the quality of work
 produced during doctoral studies. An exception is possible for professorships in
 artistic disciplines if a candidate can successfully establish special artistic aptitude as
 well as provide proof of additional artistic achievements. Proof of additional artistic
 achievements generally means a period of outstanding artistic activity of five years or
 more, provided at least three of those years were undertaken outside of the higher
 education sector.

Candidates who are **not** native German speakers must demonstrate at least basic working knowledge of German.

Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences is committed to the professional advancement of women. Applications from women are therefore explicitly welcomed and encouraged. In areas where women are underrepresented, female applicants shall be given preferential consideration in case of equal qualifications, aptitude and professional achievements in accordance with the Gender Equality Act of North Rhine-Westphalia (Landesgleichstellungsgesetz – LGG – NRW), unless there are exceptional reasons for giving preference to another candidate.

In case of equal qualifications, preferential consideration shall also be given to applications from candidates with a disability or equivalent persons pursuant to Section 2 (3) German Social Security Code, Book IX (SGB IX).

An appointment to this position is also possible under an employment contract subject to German private law.
