Free use of Radboud University Library

In the context of a growing cooperation with universities and colleges in The Netherlands, the services of the libraries at Radboud University Nijmegen have recently been made available to our students and staff free of charge. This applies to all students and staff of Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences with immediate effect.

You can apply for a library card at the service counters of the Central Library, the Law Library and the Library of Medical Sciences.

Please bring the following documents to register:

Students:

- Proof of identity and confirmation of address
- Certificate of enrollment

Staff:

- Proof of identity and confirmation of address
- Employment contract or last payslip

Forms of identification: valid passport, ID card or driver's license

<u>Confirmation of address</u>: certificate of registration/Meldebescheinigung, rental agreement, electricity bill, payslip etc.

A library card is valid for one academic year. To renew your membership, please submit your latest enrollment certificate. The academic year runs until October 1.

The library card allows you to borrow or reserve books and magazines. Access to the digital library is available via the guest computers on campus in Nijmegen. Guest logins are issued at the service counters of the Central Library and the branch libraries. This is a special arrangement granted to members of Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences by Radboud University. Unfortunately, due to the current licensing agreements with publishers, remote access to the very extensive and costly range of eJournals, eBooks etc. is only available to members of Radboud University.
