Did you study at university in your home country?

Registered refugees can apply to become 'guest auditors' at our University for free. As a guest auditor – or 'Gasthörer' – you can take part in select lectures taught in German or English. This gives you the chance to expand your knowledge and skills to new areas.

Our guest auditor programme is not restricted by age, academic background or employment status. As proof of your current refugee status, please attach a copy of your temporary residency permit to your application and send both to our Student Advisory Service.

Our Language Centre offers several German courses that you can attend for free as a registered refugee. For more information on how to join a language course, please contact our Language Centre.

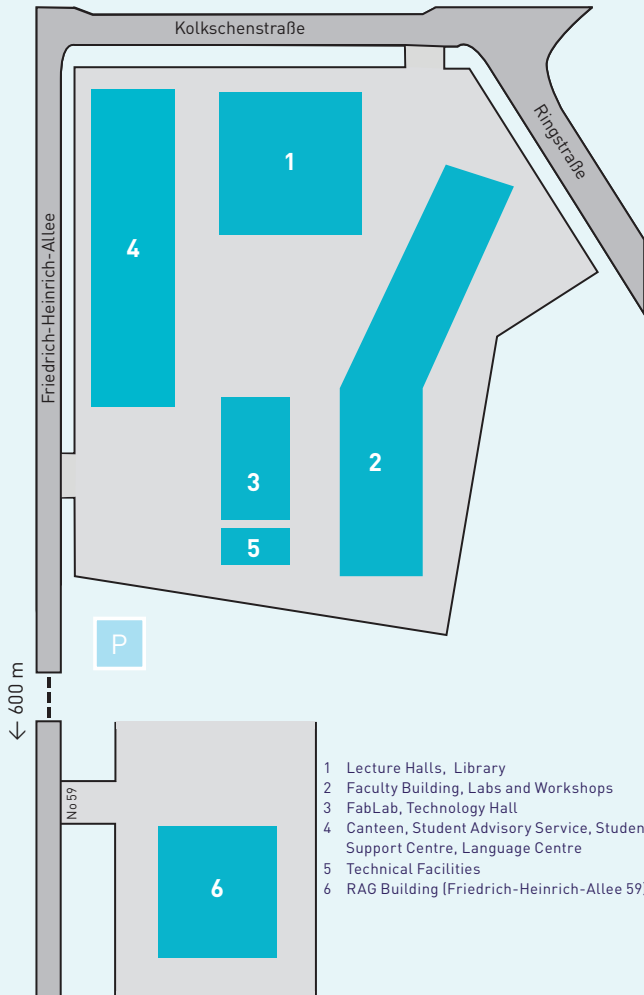
