Subject/module: IBA 3.06 Communication and Cooperation

The module consists of a lecture and an exercise (two plus two semester hours). Students are in the third semester of the undergraduate degree programme International Business Administration. Language of instruction is English.

In this module, students deal with basic models and theories regarding communication, conflict management and group processes. Professional and social as well as personal competences are taught. In this module, exercises and experiments are used to strengthen students' self-awareness. The module combines application, reflection and deepening of contents.

- Conflict and Conflict management
- Negotiations and Negotiation strategy
- Leadership and Communication
- Team Work
- Presentations – Verbal and Visual Support

Requirements:

The lecturer shall have a corresponding university degree and have practical experience. Didactic skill and the ability to hold the course with an international group of students in the English language are required (the language level shall be C1 according to the European reference framework).
