This is a module (lecture with exercise) with a duration of 4 semester hours per week. The module is to be offered on campus in the winter semester 2024/25 and will be taught in the fifth semester of the Bachelor degree programme International Business Administration as an Elective Course. Language of instruction is English.

**Content** includes, but is not limited to:

- Introduction to ERP systems
- ERP systems as socio-technical systems and their role in companies (control and organization of business processes, improving the flow of communication between functional areas, optimizing company-wide resource management, ...)
- Introduction to SAP (SAP components, technical basics, operation, maintenance of user data, role and authorization concept, ...)
- Mapping of company processes with the help of SAP (procurement, production, materials management, sales, finance and accounting, marketing, quality control, controlling, human resources, ...)
- Case studies
- Selection, implementation and use of SAP systems in companies
- Advanced concepts (SAP HANA ...)

Lecture with accompanying exercise in our PC-Pool where ERP software (especially SAP) is applied.

## **Requirements:**

The lecturer shall have a corresponding university degree and have practical experience. Didactic skill and the ability to hold the course with an international group of students in the English language are required (the language level shall be C1 according to the European reference framework).
